

Windpower Planning

Welcome to the distance education course Windpower Planning at Gotland University! Educate yourself free of charge by Internet about this fast growing renewable energy source, to be able to participate in the development of windpower!

Windpower Planning will give you an overview of windpower policy in different countries, spatial planning, environment impact, opinion and acceptance and grid integration of wind turbines. *Distance education* means that all course material, exercises and communication with the teachers is available on the Internet, with an *electronic classroom* as base.

Windpower Planning will start **Monday 30th of October 2006 and end Friday 19th of January 2007**. It will run on a part time basis (1/2 time); a 5 week full time course that runs for 10 weeks. This means that it will be possible to participate in the course by studying in the evenings and on holidays. The course language is English. Those who make all exercises and assignments will get 7,5 ECTS credits from Gotland University.

This course is free of charge. To participate you have to send an application to Gotland University. You can find Application form and more information about the course at www.hgo.se. Send an application as soon as possible, it takes some time for the administration to process applications from other countries. To be accepted for this course you should have passed the course Windpower Basics, or have similar prior knowledge. On the website the last day for application is March 15, but you can apply until the course starts. *The Application Code is: E1222*
